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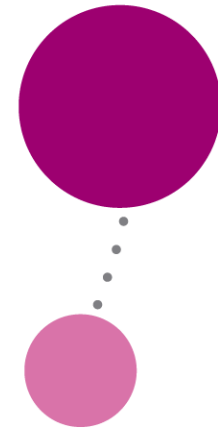

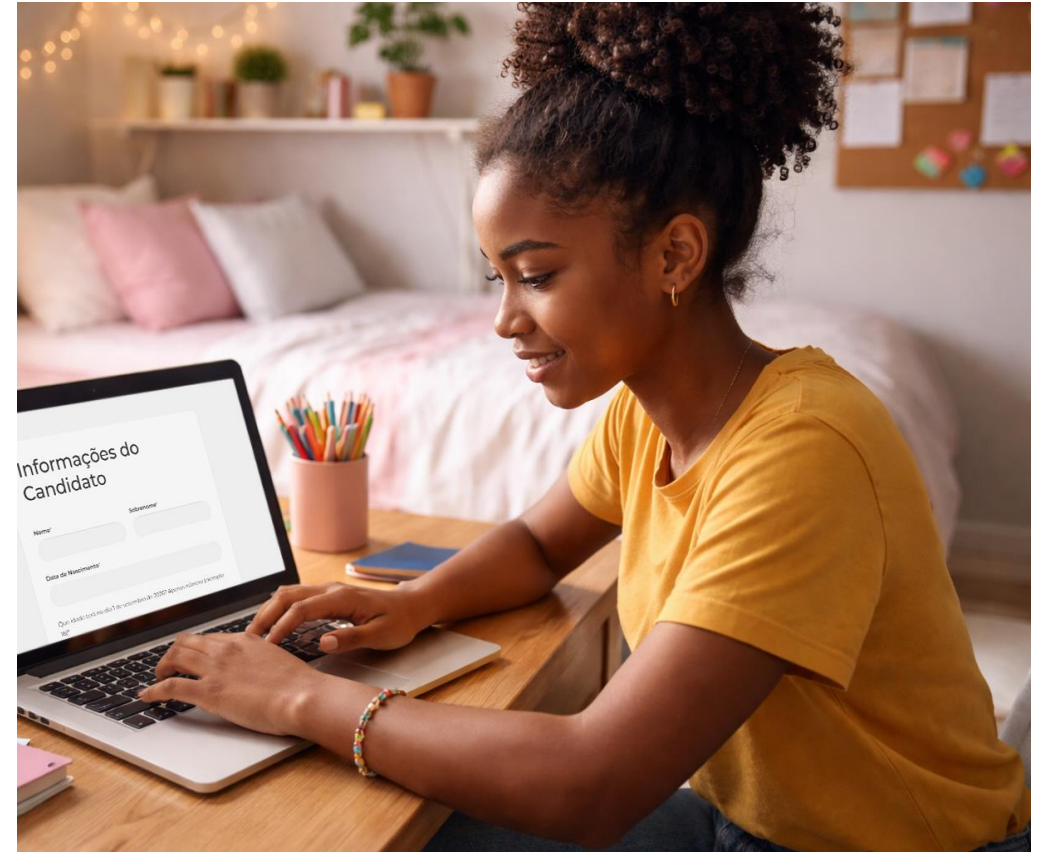
Early Years Teacher Status-Key facts



- Lead teaching and learning across 0-5years with Early Years Teacher Status (Not QTS)
- Train for free! Fully funded by the DfE
- Employer incentive for GEB route
- Childminder offer
- Learn about the progression in curriculum into Key stage 1 and 2
- Develop your leadership skills
- Work with other professionals
- Strengthen your passion for Early Years!

Application

- Complete all questions fully e.g. individual needs
- Check eligibility e.g. GCSE's, degree
- Share information that is needed to support your programme journey
- Upload clear copies of documents requested e.g. proof of address
- Follow guidance from the team
- Read interview preparation guide



Interview

- Be prepared!
- Arrive on time
- Look on the website
- Have all your documents ready
- Prepare and practice your presentation
- Consider programme requirements e.g. placement



Offer and conditions

- Conditional offer
- Learner agreement
- Employer declaration
- Safeguarding training and DBS check
- Medical Questionnaire
- Any extra conditions e.g.
Replacement GCSE certificates
- Meet deadlines quickly to secure
your place



Equivalency Tests

GCSE Qualifications and equivalency tests

If applicants do not hold GCSEs in maths, English or science (no grade C/4 or above), they can complete equivalency tests.

*GCSE science equivalency test can be either Biology or combined.

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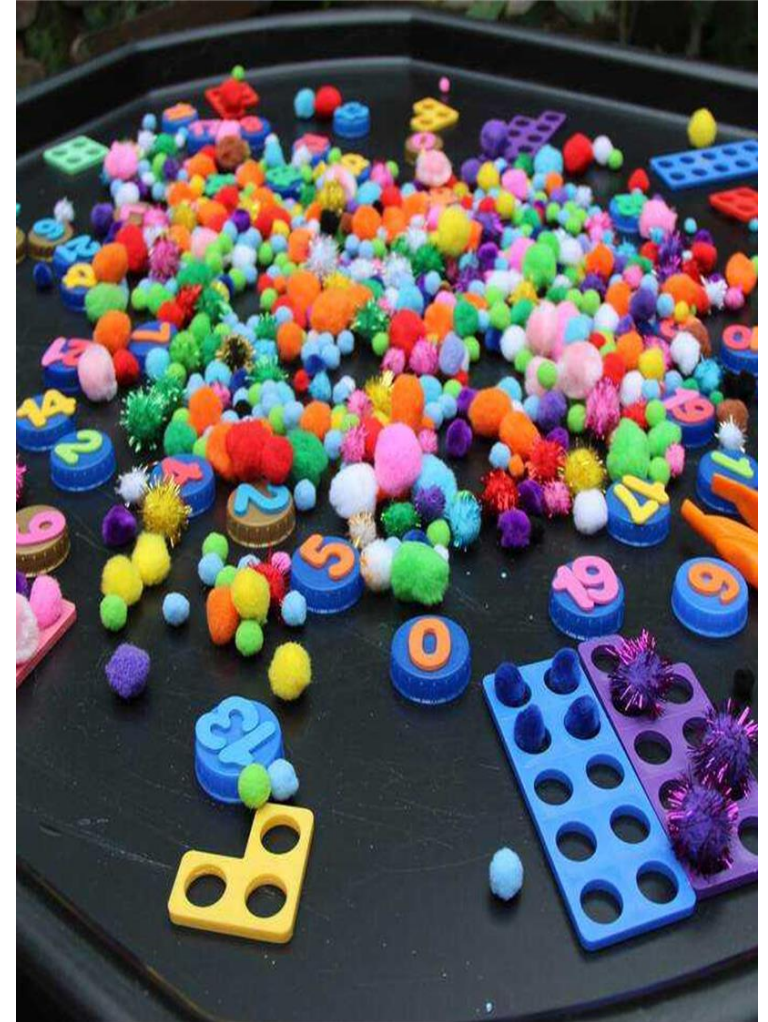
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ITT requirements for placement

- Every student must cover the age groups from 0-5 years as a minimum (DfE requirement)
- All students must complete a placement of at least 25 days.
- Placements for childminders will depend on the number and ages of children that you have on roll.
- GE students must complete a minimum of 120 placement days. (**At least 4 days a week**) We will support with organising placements.
- Placements need to offer a variety and depth of experience to enable student teachers to meet all of the Early Years Teaching Standards
- **Placements are completed in at least 2** different settings (Rated good or Outstanding with Ofsted) Your own setting is setting number one! Some students may need 3 settings.
- Placements must be in a setting which delivers the EYFS or works to National Curriculum expectations



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How is Early Years Teacher Status assessed?



- Formatively which leads into summative assessment
- Includes observations, a reflective account, sequences of work and termly targets
- Demonstration of mastery of the EYITT curriculum
- A summative judgement that each trainee meets the Teachers' Standards (Early Years)
- Exam board and recommendation for the award of Early Years Teacher Status
