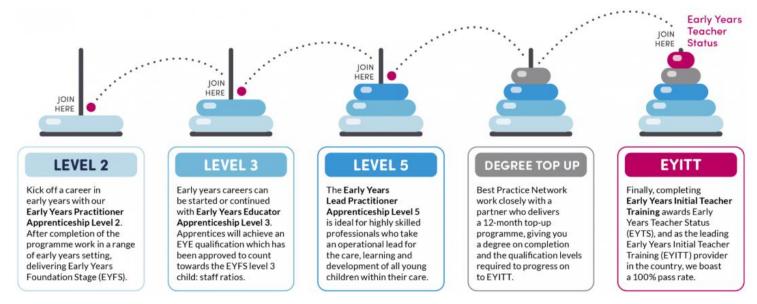

- Train Once you've chosen your new apprentice(s), we'll handle enrolment and training setup — ensuring a smooth start.

Our screening and matching process ensures every learner joins a team where they can grow, contribute, and feel valued.

Our process includes:

- A screening call with every applicant to discuss their experience, interests, and ideal setting type.
- Checking current vacancies to find the most suitable opportunities.
- Guiding candidates on how to approach local settings if no immediate match is available.
- Sharing CVs and profiles with potential employers.
- Supporting stay-and-play sessions or work trials to ensure the best fit for both sides.
- Providing ongoing feedback and continued support until placement is secured.
