<b>Route:</b> Primary Mainstream Teacher Apprenticeship 3-7 or 5-11	<ul> <li>Step 1 - Induction Call <ul> <li>You will Receive a call from one of our placement coordinators</li> <li>Discuss your current situation (working in a school vs looking for a school)</li> <li>You have applied for the Apprenticeship route: What does this mean?</li> <li>Travel expectations</li> <li>Suggestions of schools</li> <li>Prepare for the Call</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Step 2 - Create your Profile</li> <li>We ask student teachers to make sure their CV is up to date; We use it to send it to schools that might be interested in offering an apprenticeship opportunity</li> <li>Check : <u>What Schools Are Looking For</u></li> <li>Update your CV: Include clear, specific examples of achievements, skills, and experience <u>Click HERE for Guidance</u></li> <li>Prepare a Personal Statement to act as your cover letter when you are reaching out to schools : <u>Click HERE for Guidance</u></li> </ul>
